The President requested \$32.089 billion for NIH; the House and Senate FY 2011 appropriations bills each provided \$32.007 billion for NIH.

<sup>4</sup> The Coalition's NIH target is 3.6 percent of the overall funding target agreed upon by the broader health research community, including the Ad Hoc Group for Medical Research. This target for overall NIH funding is \$35 billion in FY 2011.

<sup>5</sup> This figure represents what we expect health services research would receive if it maintains its current proportion of overall VA Medical and Prosthetic Research funding (roughly 15.5 percent). The House and Senate FY 2011 appropriations bills each provided \$590 million for this research. Final FY2011 funding is \$589 million.

<sup>6</sup> The Coalition's VHA target is 16 percent of the overall funding target agreed upon by the Friends of VA Medical Care and Health Research (FOVA). FOVA's target for overall VHA research funding is \$700 million in FY 2011.
